## Foreign Country Requirements

Some countries, in fact, require that you have yours valid for at least six months past the planned dates of travel. As a result, it is recommended that approximately nine months prior to the expiration date, you renew. You can prevent any unforeseen problems by already being prepared in this way.

## Valid Period

If you were over 16 years old when it was issued, your document will be valid for ten years. If you were younger than 16, it is valid only 5 years. So, you won't need to renew very often as long as you keep track.

## Emergency Situations

If there is an emergency, there are still solutions available to you. If you do not have a valid document and a life or death emergency involving death or serious illness or injury occurs to someone in your immediate family in a country that requires a passport, you can appear in person at a passport agency for emergency service. You may have to provide documentation about the emergency.
