For example, the central area is dedicated to Simon Bolivar, a man who played a key role in gaining Latin America's independence from the Spanish, having personally led Bolivia, Colombia, Peru, Ecuador, Panama, and Venezuela to independence. He is also responsible for creating a union of independent Central and South American nations, which he called Gran Colombia. The Plaza Bolivar is a central square named after him, and is a great place to walk around and explore.

Museo de Arte Contemporaneo

Museo de Arte Contemporaneo is considered to be one of the best fine arts museums in South America, and it's a unique cultural experience to visit. Housing works by famous artists such as Picasso, Miro, Matisse, and more. Another important museum is the Galería de Arte Nacional, a museum that features Venezuelan historical art. Over 4000 pieces are on display, and it also shares a building with the Museo de Bellas Artes, which has art exhibits from all over the world.

Avila National Park

There are many places in Caracas to unwind and relax after a long day of exploring the city. The Parque del Este is a good spot. It's a beautiful park and even features a little zoo and a planetarium. The Jardin Botanico, which was initiated in 1944, is another favorite and contains 2000 species of plants. Avila for some absolutely eye-opening views of the city and surrounding mountains.
