Cheap Holidays In Berlin

The capital of Germany, Berlin is the place to go for [cheap holidays](#). Although there are many things to do in Berlin, be sure to visit the Stasi headquarters and the Berlin Wall, which had a profound effect on the country. Most tourists come to Berlin to see the remains of the Berlin Wall. A relatively long stretch in Berlin along Muehlenstrasse is worth visiting, and have had murals painted on it, and were touched up for the recent 20th anniversary of the Fall of the Wall.

The Berlin Wall Memorial has some very interesting historical background and is well worth a visit. It's a good idea to purchase a guide book and research beforehand all the places you'd like to visit when you come to Berlin on [holiday deals](#). There is a museum next to Checkpoint Charlie which has displays on the people who tried to cross the Wall into West Germany as well as Berlin Wall memorabilia. Long regarded as one of the world's top intelligence agencies, the Stasi headquarters are now allowing visitors into their headquarters. The secret police organisation, The Ministry for State Security, was created back in 1950. At the beginning, 274, 000 people were employed but by 1989, this number had been drastically cut back to only 91,000.

In the museum, you can roam around through the old offices of the various colonels and other important figures, the conference room (complete with a huge poster of Germany), as well as the common rooms such as the kitchen and cafeteria. There is an interesting display on the first floor, detailing the history of the organisation and which methods they used to track their enemies.
