Getting a Passport Expedited in the United States

Citizens of the United States in need of expedited passport service don't have time for detailed explanations. They need just the facts and they need them quickly. This short article will present you with solutions to the most typically asked inquiries about getting a [passport quickly](#).

How do you expedite a passport?

One can find three different means to get a passport application expedited. One, you request it when you send in your application. Two, you schedule an appointment and visit a regional passport agency. Three, get an experienced expeditor to take your application to the agency for you.

How long does it take for expedited service?

Your passport will be delivered to you in two to three weeks when you mail the form (when renewing or adding pages) or take it to an acceptance facility (when applying for a new passport or one for a minor). Forms taken to a regional passport processing center are frequently processed the same day. You can determine how swiftly you would like to obtain your passport when making a request through a passport expeditor. It can take 10 business days or they can get for you the same day when you make an application through a [emergency passport service](#).

What should I expect to pay for expedited passport service?

You will pay \$60 to the State Department to expedite a passport whether you apply by mail, at a local passport application acceptance facility or at a regional passport processing center. Expediter's fees range from \$65 to \$299 or more, depending on the company you choose and the speed at which you need to get the application processed.

Is it possible to request expedited service for a form that has already been submitted for standard service?

This request cannot be submitted by mail nor can you solicit the intervention of an expediting service. The only option is to personally visit the nearest regional passport processing center. You ought to check the status of your application before you do this. It may be processed faster than anticipated. If it appears that your application will not be processed in time for your trip, phone the National Passport Information Center .

Are professional passport expeditors a scam?

As a whole, passport expeditors are valid service providers. This does not mean that every single passport expediting service is reliable. Much like every other service business, you will find some that are competent and reliable and others that are not. You should examine carefully and choose shrewdly the passport expeditor you decide to work with. If possible, look into how long the company has been operating, if there are any grievances against them and what kind of customer rating they have. Also, try to contact them. This should tell you something about how they care for customers.

Something else you should evaluate is the price. As mentioned above, a same day passport can cost you hundreds of dollars when you combine all the fees . Even so, it might actually cost more to present the passport application yourself, particularly if you live far away from the processing agency. There are the costs of travel, your meals, parking, possible lodging stay and other costs. When you take all this into mind, going by way of a professional [passport expeditor](#) may actually be the best choice.
