Issues To Consider About Renew United States Passport

Documentation

Individuals can have their document updated in several ways, however, many people prefer to do so through the mail. This is generally due to the time saving benefits that doing so can provide, especially when compared to doing things in person. In order to achieve this, individuals will need to include an undamaged passport that's already expired, along with the appropriate form and other items.

Location

Residents within the United States will need to ensure that their previous passport was issued when they were at least 16 years of age or older should they plan to send a form through the mail. However, it's always a good idea to verify certain age requirements, which can be done online or over the phone. This is more the case if you happen to need your new document quickly, so that you can avoid any unforeseen trouble. Expired passports also need to have been issued no more than 15 years prior to the time of renewal.

Name Change

Those who plan to mail in their application and other items will also need to ensure that their name is the same since the time their original document was issued. Legal documents will need to be available in order to prove the identity of a person who has had their name changed since their original document was made. For instance, if an individual were to get married after their original passport had been issued, they would need to have a legal marriage license on record.

Processing Center

You can usually find an address to send for your new passport online. For instance, those who live within the United States can send their papers to the National Passport Processing Center, which is located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

DS-11

If you don't meet the necessary requirements in order to send your items through the mail or would prefer to do things in person, you will likely need a different form in order to do this. For example, those in the United States generally have to fill out a DS-11 form, which is something that will need to be signed in person rather than beforehand.

Government ID

Those who want up-to-date documentation will need to bring in a government-issued identification card with a picture, providing they want to process their paperwork in person. Usually, a document that proves an individual is a citizen within a country will also be needed, such as a certificate of birth, along with two photographs that are able to meet certain size requirements. These items can be brought to a number of acceptance facilities or related agencies.

Individuals who happen to be in a rush can also seek help from professional services. Services like this can be ideal for getting a [renew U.S. passport](#) quickly - sometimes even within a 24-hour period. Generally, those who lack the time or who have last-minute travel arrangements to contend with tend to prefer this method the most.
