Manjanggul is the world's largest lava tube and it is located in a cave filled with many other very interesting yet very strange lava formations. A very rare species of bat calls this cave home. The geological formations made from the cooled lava are interesting, so don't miss out on seeing The Lava Pillar, The Lava Turtle, and the Wing-Shaped Wall.

Yet another World Heritage Site is Seongsan Ilchubong, a very old volcano which tourists are able to climb to the top of. People regard it as a national symbol of Jeju, and many will recommend climbing to the top to see a sunrise. One of Jeju's claims to fame is the collection of particularly odd museums they have. For example, there is a Green Tea Museum, a Teddy Bear Museum, and several other bizarre ones. Loveland is almost a museum. It's actually a park filled with sexually suggestive sculptures. Oh, and there's also a sex shop on site too.
