The aquarium itself is quite large - one of the largest in the world in fact - and it houses all sorts of neat animals, like manta rays, sharks, beavers, and pelicans. It's easy to spend a few hours just enjoying the cool air and the beautiful underwater landscapes. If you are looking for a peaceful spot to relax outside, head to the Jardim Botânico. Created centuries ago by the current King of Portugal, it contains many strange and beautiful plants. The King once said he wanted one of every plant in the world, and while he never reached that, many of the interesting plants still remain.

### Gulbenkian Museum

If you're interested in more of Lisbon's history, head to the Gulbenkian Museum, which holds ancient Persian and Egyptian art, as well as paintings by some of the most famous artists in the world: Monet, Rubens, Rembrandt, and more. Another scenic spot to visit is Cascais, a charming fishing village where royalty once lived. It's also the site of Cidadela fort and more important landmarks.
