# **Lost/Stolen U S Passport Replacement - Tips For Stressed Travellers**

Losing your passport or having it stolen is a scary situation no matter where it happens but it is probably harder to handle if it happens while you are traveling abroad. The required documents are the same as those documents required when you apply for your first passport. You will need the application, proof of citizenship, proof of identity, two passport photos, proof of your intent to travel and an additional form concerning the lost or stolen passport.
