Other landmarks include Myslewicki Palace, the Little Whitehouse, the Temple of Diana, and the Roman amphitheater.

Warsaw made a bold statement during the Second World War, as mentioned previously. Two separate uprisings took place, each showing Warsaw's defiance of the Nazis. The persecution by the Nazis of Warsaw's Jewish population - which was almost a third of the total population - was a prime factor. The Warsaw Uprising Museum outlines these uprisings with captivating displays of documentaries, leaflets, and newspapers that chronologically detail the events of the Uprising, including some truly incredible numbers. Don't forget to head to the back to see the Garden of Memories and the large wall with the names of the thousands of victims of the Uprising.

Old Town, or Stare Miasto, is a historical district of Warsaw that was actually completely leveled by the Nazis during the War. Since then, all the beautiful cobblestone streets, Gothic-style buildings, baroque palaces, churches, and more were reconstructed. Declared an official UNESCO World Heritage Site, this area is certainly very interesting to explore with its colorful buildings, St. John's Cathedral, the Barbican, a gorgeous palace, Zygmunt's Column, and more.

Warsaw is a thriving city with a turbulent past that has transformed into the moving, interesting, and worthwhile place to visit it is today. Called the "phoenix city" for its amazing recovery after 80% of the buildings were destroyed in the war, it's an prime spot for a vacation.
